### Supply Corps Internship Programs Fall 2021

The Supply Corps internship programs provide junior officers with an exceptional opportunity to gain experience in Supply Corps' principal competencies, explore functional subspecialties, and engage with seniors, peers, subordinates, mission partners, and suppliers. These internship programs provide Supply Corps officers knowledge and understanding of our systems, processes and their interconnectivity, and ultimately ensure the expeditious delivery of services and material solutions to the warfighter.

Internship applications are being considered for the following programs: Business Enterprise Supply Chain Management (BEM), Petroleum Management (POL), and Integrated Logistics Support (ILS). Additional information, to include a sample application, is available on the MyNavyHR website. Endorsed applications are due no later than 30 Sep 2021. Submissions must be sent as a PDF, without Social Security numbers, to [supplycorpscarerecounselor@navy.mil](mailto:supplycorpscarerecounselor@navy.mil). Applicants will receive a confirmation e-mail upon receipt.

Warfare qualified officers (O1-O3) with a projected rotation date (PRD) between October 2021 and October 2022 and who either have or will have completed one operational tour are eligible. Officers in the paygrade of O3 will only be considered if participation will not affect their opportunity to complete or start their second operational tour prior to zoning for promotion to O4. By submitting an application, officers agree to complete a 24-month internship and to remain on active duty for an additional tour of at least 12-months.
