Supply Corps Reserve Officers Nominated for Promotion

Nominations for the promotion of Rear Admiral (lower half) Jacquelyn McClelland to the rank of rear admiral and Captain Charles P. Kirol to the rank of rear admiral (lower half) were received in the Senate and referred to the Committee on Armed Services.

RDML McClelland is currently serving as vice director, Navy Staff, Office of the Chief of Naval Operations, Washington, D.C.

McClelland's flag assignments include commander, Navy Expeditionary Logistics Support Group (NAVELSG) and Reserve director, Logistics, Fleet Supply and Ordnance, U.S. Pacific Fleet, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.

Her previous assignments include deputy chief of staff, Fleet Operations, Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Global Logistics Support, San Diego, California; joint team lead for Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Defense Distribution Center, New Cumberland, Pennsylvania; commanding officer, Navy Reserve (NR), NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center (FLC), Jacksonville, Florida; operations officer, NAVSUP Headquarters, Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania; deputy group commander, NAVELSG FORWARD, Kuwait, in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom; commanding officer, Navy Cargo Handling Battalion (NCHB) 12; commanding officer, DLA Support Team, Afghanistan; J-31 operations officer, and chief of staff, NR DLA Contingency Support Team Headquarters, Fort Belvoir, Virginia; executive officer, NR Naval Regional Contracting Center (NRCC), Naples, Italy; administration officer, operations officer, and executive officer, NR Navy Petroleum Office Headquarters, Fort Belvoir, Virginia; supply officer and assistant officer in charge, NR Cheatham Annex, Williamsburg, Virginia; special projects officer, mobilization officer, and training officer, NR NRCC Detachment London, England; and training officer, NR Naval Support Center, Norfolk, Virginia.

CAPT Kirol is currently serving as Navy Reserve deputy commander, Pacific Fleet, N4, Logistics Readiness Cell, San Diego, California.

Kirol earned a Bachelor of Science in Accounting (Summa Cum Laude) from the University of Florida in 1993. Upon graduation from Florida, he received his commission as an ensign in the United States Navy Supply Corps. He attended the Navy Supply Corps School, Athens, Georgia, and went on to graduate from the Navy Submarine School. In December 2011, he received a Master of Business Administration from Indiana University and a Logistics Certification from the University of North Carolina through the Department of Defense LOGTECH Supply Chain Program.

His active duty tours include N4 for Commander, Submarine Group TWO; supply officer, USS Albuquerque (SSN 706); and N4A, Submarine Squadron Two.

CAPT Kirol joined the U.S. Navy Selected Reserve (SELRES) after 13 years of submarine supply support. Since 9/11, he has mobilized and forward deployed twice in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom. His last extended mobilization was to the U.S. Central Command area of operations as the chief staff officer for NAVELSG FORWARD, Golf.

His Reserve assignments include commanding officer, NR, NAVSUP FLC Sigonella; commodore, 2ND Navy Expeditionary Logistics Regiment, Williamsburg, Virginia; commanding officer, NR, DLA Troop Support, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; commanding officer, NCHB-8, Fort Dix, New Jersey; as well as numerous other SELRES leadership roles in Defense Contract Management Agency, Harbor Defense Command, NRCC, Navy Supply Support Battalion 2, Navy Cargo Handling, and Port Group 3.

Kirol is authorized to wear the Command Ashore insignia and is a qualified Submarine Supply Corps Warfare Officer and Navy Expeditionary Supply Corps Officer. His personal awards include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (four awards), Navy Commendation Medal (seven awards), and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (two awards).
