 - Chapter financial contributions to NSCF – date/amount
6. Chapter President name, submission date, signature
7. OPTIONAL, **repeat OPTIONAL**, SIGNIFICANT BACKUP INFORMATION, documentation or photographs as desired to support bullets mentioned in required format. Volume over significance negatively received.

Volunteer(s) of the Year will receive either a framed certificate or suitable memento, as well as global recognition via *The Oakleaf* and NSCF website and social media channels.
