Supply Corps Post Graduate Education Screening (810/811 Board)

Operational requirements affecting the availability of selected 810/811 officers for the fall 2020 program necessitates a Supply Corps Post Graduate Education Supplemental Screen Board. The board will convene 13 January 2020 and will select officers from promotion year groups (YGs) 2011-2013 to participate in both the Supply Acquisition/Distribution Management (810) and the University of Kansas Petroleum Management (811) Programs to commence in fall of 2020. This supplemental screen board will be in addition to the annual 810/811 board that will convene in May 2020.

Officers selected for the 810 Program will receive a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree from one of the nation's top business schools and earn the Supply Acquisition/Distribution Management subspecialty code (1301P). Officers selected for the 811 Program will attend the University of Kansas and earn an MBA degree from the School of Business, a graduate certificate in Petroleum Management from the School of Engineering, and a Petroleum Management subspecialty code (1307P).

All officers in YGs 2011-2013 who request screening by the supplemental board via a package to the Board President will be eligible for consideration. Eligibility requirements include: completion of two operational tours by July 2020; a warfare qualification; an Academic Profile Code (APC) on file; and a GMAT or GRE score report.

In the package to the Board President, eligible officers who wish to be considered must include the following:

- Letter to the Board stating preferred program
- GMAT or GRE Score Report
- APC waiver request (if necessary)
