

Rear Admiral Aubrey Bourgeois, SC, USN (Ret.) passed away on December 4, 2011; three days shy of celebrating his 104th birthday. He was the oldest living Supply Corps Officer, and oldest graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy. Funeral Mass will be held at the Nativity of Our Lord Catholic Church (<http://www.nativityoffourlordcc.org>) in Pensacola on Wednesday, 7 December at 1100. RADM Bourgeois will be buried at Barrancas Cemetery at Naval Air Station Pensacola, on Thursday, 8 December at 1015 (<http://www.cem.va.gov/cems/nchp/barrancas.asp>).

Rear Admiral Bourgeois retired from the Pearl Harbor Naval Supply Center in November 1963, after 33 years of naval service. Previous assignments included: USS HENDERSON (AP 1); Division Disbursing Officer for Mine Division 1 and Destroyer Division 13; Assistant Incoming Stores and Purchasing Officer, Naval Station, San Diego; Assistant to the Supply Officer, Puget Sound Navy Yard, Bremerton, WA; USS NEOSHO (AO 23); Supply and Accounting Officer, Naval Air Station Kodiak, AK; Senior Assistant to the Supply Officer, Naval Air Station Quonset Point, RI; Supply and Accounting Officer, Naval Air Station, Pearl Harbor, HI; ASO and NASD, Philadelphia, PA; Supply and Fiscal Officer, Naval Air Station Corpus Christi, TX; Officer In Charge, Ordnance Stock Office, Washington, D.C.; Student, Industrial College of the Armed Forces; Supply Officer; Naval Shipyard, Charleston, SC; Force Supply Officer, CINCNELM; Inspector General of the Supply Corps; and Commanding Officer, NSC Pearl Harbor with additional duty as Supply Officer on the staff of Commander, Naval Base Pearl Harbor, and Fourteenth Naval District Supply Officer.
