

RADM H. C. Donley, SC, USN (Ret.) passed away on Wednesday April 11, 2007, at Saint John Hospital, Leavenworth, Kan. RADM Donley retired Sept. 1, 1982, after serving as Commander, Defense Construction Supply Center, Columbus, Ohio. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Kansas and his master's degree from Stanford University and a master's in business administration from the Stanford University, Palo Alto, Calif.

His previous duty stations included USS Palau (CVE 122); Supply Officer, USS Healy (DD 672); Naval Air Station, Alameda; Naval Shipyard, Pearl Harbor; Bureau of Supplies and Accounts, Washington, D.C.; Supply Officer, USS Observation Island (EAG 154); Navy Ships Parts Control Center, Mechanicsburg, Pa.; Navy Purchasing Branch, Naval Supply Depot, Yokosuka, Japan; Special Assistant and Aide to the Assistance Secretary of the Navy (I&L), Washington, D.C.; Commanding Officer, Navy Supply Corps School; Director of Supply Corps Personnel; Naval Supply Systems Command, Washington, D.C.; and Commanding Officer, Naval Supply Center, Oakland, Calif.

He was awarded the Legion of Merit (Gold Star in lieu of Second Award), National Defense Service Medal with Bronze Star, Meritorious Unit Commendation Medal and the Vietnam Service Medal.

RADM Donley is survived by his wife, M.J. Supplee-Donley of Leavenworth; his sister, Jeanne Masterson of Leavenworth; and two sons, Kurt Donley of Florida and Tad Donley of Houston.

He was preceded in death by his first wife Mary Alyce Kuhn Donley and a son, John Kuhn Donley.
