

Rear Admiral William M. Oller, SC, USN (Retired), passed away the week of February 25 after suffering a long battle with cancer. He was 83 years old.

Rear Admiral Oller retired July 1, 1977. He was the Commanding Officer, Naval Supply Center, Norfolk, Va. He is a graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy and received his master's degree from George Washington University.

His previous duty stations included Commander, Defense Fuel Supply Center, Cameron Station, Alexandria, VA; Supply Officer, USS AUCILLA (AO 56); Supply Officer and Comptroller, Naval Ordnance Plant, Macon, Ga.; Executive Officer, NSC Newport, RI; Director, Office of Information Systems Planning and Development, Office of the Secretary of the Navy; and Executive Officer, Navy Ships Parts Control Center, Mechanicsburg, Pa.

He was awarded the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal (with gold star); Joint Service Commendation Medal; World War II American Theater; World War II Occupation (European Clasp); World War II Victory and National Defense Service Medal.

A memorial service will be held Saturday, March 8, 11 a.m., at the Falcon's Landing Chapel, Sterling, VA, followed by a reception in the auditorium.

Rear Admiral Oller is survived by his wife Doris, two sons and five grandchildren.
