

CDR Richard (Rick) L. Foley, SC, USN (Ret.) passed away in August 2012. His Supply Corps career included tours at the Navy Supply Corps School; USS Ozbourn; Armed Forces South, Naples, Italy; Portsmouth Navy Shipyard, VA; USS Belknap; Commander Naval Surface Forces, Atlantic; and Industrial College of the Armed Forces. He received his MBA from Harvard Business School.
