APPLICATION FOR THE NAVY SUPPLY CORPS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
(Rev. 12/2014)

PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY AS SOME THINGS HAVE CHANGED

SOURCE OF SCHOLARSHIP MONEY: Navy Supply Corps Foundation, and various organizations, individuals, and memorial scholarship funds established by members of the Navy Supply Corps and/or their families and friends.

ELIGIBILITY: For all scholarships, the applicant must:

1. Be a spouse, child or grandchild of a living or deceased regular, retired, reserve or prior service Supply Corps officer.
2. Be a spouse or child of an Active or Retired Enlisted with supply enlisted rating (e.g., AK, SK, MS/CS, SH, DK, LI, PC, LS).
3. Recipient must attend a two (2) or four (4) year accredited college and should be a full-time undergraduate student. (Note: Spouse scholarships are available for spouses who are enrolled for a minimum of 6 hours per semester, undergraduate only)

The National Institute for the Blind (NIB) and the National Institute for the Severely Handicapped (NISH) sponsors a scholarship to an eligible applicant who is blind or has a severe disability. Applicants for this scholarship must submit documentation substantiating their disability.

Spouse Scholarship - A spouse of an active duty or reserve officer or enlisted supply rating. Must be enrolled for at least 6 hours a semester in a 2 or 4 year accredited institution.

Community College or Technical School Scholarship - See eligibility in #1 and 2 above. School must be accredited and must be a full time student.

GPA - All students must have a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 Scale to be eligible for any of these scholarships.

This scholarship is for undergraduate students only.

Note: Acceptance by the applicant/recipient of an official appointment to attend one of the service academies will disqualify an applicant.

SELECTION: The Navy Supply Corps Foundation Scholarship Program Selection Board shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, national or ethnic origin, or religious

preference. Award is based on academic achievement, character, demonstrated leadership or leadership potential, extracurricular activities and financial need.

DEADLINE: Thursday, MARCH 1, 2018

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION AND SUBMISSION OF THE NSCF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM:

Online portion:

- 1. The student applicant** is the only person who should complete this application online. **Applicants must create a user account on the Foundation website, indicating their intention of applying for a scholarship.** Sponsor accounts must NOT be used for applying. If sponsor is retired/deceased, the information must be that which pertained at the time of his/her retirement or death.
- 2. Review** the application for completeness and be certain to answer all questions. Fill in all blocks. If "None" or "Not Applicable," so state. Use "NA", "None", or "000" when needed. Before submitting, please review all answers.
- 3. ESSAYS - TWO** Essays must be uploaded at the end of the application in .doc, .docx, or .rtf format only.

Two essays are required. Question "A" is mandatory. In addition, choose one more subject from B or C for your second essay. Essays should be approximately 350-500 words (double spaced).

Use A, B, or C to indicate the topic you have chosen at the beginning of each essay. Both essays need to be contained within one document. Be sure to separate the essays with a page break. Document name should not contain your name or special characters.

- A. *REQUIRED.*** During his inaugural address, President John F. Kennedy said "Ask not what your country can do for you – ask what you can do for your country." What would you like to do that contributes to society and the public good.
- B.** Describe a time when you were a leader. What did you learn? What did you do well and what improvements would you have made?
- C.** Describe a failure that you have had in your life. What did you learn from it? How would you do it different?

Mail in Portion: The following should be mailed to our office in one complete package when possible. Faxes will not be accepted.

1. STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR) - Provide a copy of the **processed Electronic Student Aid Report**. This can ONLY be obtained from filling out the FAFSA form. This report is generated from the info you submitted and can be downloaded from the FAFSA website approximately 4 days after submitting your FAFSA form. Please print out the “Electronic Student Aid Report” from the FAFSA website. Please click here to see an example of the SAR (**sample of FAFSA**).

PLEASE PLAN AHEAD SINCE THIS CANNOT BE DONE AT THE LAST MINUTE.

2. LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION - Please provide a letter from someone other than an academic teacher.

3. TRANSCRIPTS *- Sealed, Official, Certified High School or College Transcripts should be mailed to our office. Please try and mail them with your whole package, however, we will accept transcripts directly from the school. *Transcripts sent from the school may be sent electronically or by mail.* All students should include transcripts through fall semester 2017. ***College Freshman** - include fall semester 2017 as well as high school transcripts.

4. NIB/NISH – If applying for the NIB/NISH scholarship, please mail documentation of blindness/disability.

5. Copy of the Signature form, Check sheet and Mailing Instruction. (Checksheet)

PLEASE RETURN YOUR APPLICATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. It is your responsibility to ensure that your application is **received** at the Foundation office by the close of business Thursday, March 1, 2018. ***PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A POSTMARK DEADLINE DATE***, NO EXCEPTIONS. Faxes will NOT be accepted.
