



Agenda for NSCF, Mechanicsburg Chapter Meeting 19 Aug 16

- I. Meeting was called to order at 1153 by LCDR Evelyn Lee, Executive Vice President.
- II. Treasurer's Report
 1. LCDR Eric Coomes, Treasurer, provided a report on financial status of the chapter. Current account balance is \$11,863.73. Ear marked funds include Chotoberfest seed money (\$1500.00), Travel funds in support of NSCF Chapter President's Meeting (\$500.00) and contribution to the parent foundation (\$8,000.00). This leaves operating funds within the \$2,000.00 - \$3,000.00 parameter. LCDR Albert Sonon stated that there may be a funding needed in support of the Supply Corps Ball. More details to follow.
 2. Current emblematic inventory includes: 19 Flags, 29 Mugs, 7 Small Oak Leaves, 5 Large Oak Leaves and 26 Koozies.
- III. Previous Events:
 1. 24 Jul 16: Family Picnic @ Harrisburg Senators (AO: LT Ty Shaffer, DDSP). AO was not present at the meeting. LCDR Dave Jones, Chief Operating Officer, stated the picnic was a good event and the venue and seating were also very good. LCDR Lee stated that the event start time should be coordinated with the venue to ensure guests have access in a timely manner.
 2. 5 Aug 16: Pro Dev Tour Hershey Medical (AOs: CDR Jenkins, NAVSUP WSS/LTJG Tounkara, NAVSUP WSS). AO was not present at the meeting. LCDR Jones stated the event was well received by all 18 participants. Hershey provided a great inbrief and tour and dialogue flowed easily between all parties. The key takeaway is that Hershey and the Navy are different organizations but Supply Chain Management is fundamentally the same. Hershey marketing took pictures. LCDR Jones will find out if copies are available for further forwarding to Chapter Historian, LCDR Sean Neer.
- IV. Upcoming Events (NSCF):
 1. TBD: Summer Golf Fundraiser (AOs: LCDR Sean Neer, NAVSUP HQ/Capt. Jerry Woods, NAVSUP WSS). LCDR Neer stated that 9 September is not an option for the Golf fundraiser due to the Patriots Day ceremony. 21 October is the primary date for the event and 28 October is the secondary date.
 2. 23 Sep: Phil-Mech Games (AO: LCDR Eric Coomes, NAVSUP WSS Mech). LCDR Coomes has drafted a save the date announcement. Start time is 0800.
 3. 14 Oct 16: Choptoberfest (AO: LT Roxie Allen, NAVSUP BSC). AO was not present at the meeting. LCDR Coomes stated that a save the date has been distributed for the event and the board is standing by for any monetary support requests.
 4. Quarterly ADM Buckman Social (TBD; tentatively set for Oct 2016 in conjunction with roadshow). No further updates. Event is still TBD.
- IV. Upcoming Events (Other):
 1. 1 Oct 16: Navy Ball. A vote was conducted on providing a donation of \$250.00 to supplement babysitting services for the event. The motion to provide the donation passed 5 to 1.
 2. 24 Feb 17: Supply Corps Ball. LCDR Sonon, event Action Officer, stated that the save the date has been distributed. The theme for the event is Italian; ticket prices will be announced soon. Stan Short, Owner of Fantomworks, is the guest speaker. There are 30 rooms available for reservation at SpringHill Suites, Marriot.
- V. Open Discussion/Closing Remarks:
 1. CY16/17 schedule of events review. NSTR.

2. Emblematics price point revaluation (AO: LTJG Tounkara, WSS). AO was not present for meeting. Limited conversation was held on the topic. LCDR Sonon suggested a 50% off sale for a limited time to move stagnant stock.
3. Admiral's Cup discussion/AO assignment. LCDR Jones suggested the Admiral's Cup be open to organizations in Mechanicsburg to include DLA and allow civilians to participate. Targeted timeframe is next Spring. No AO was assigned at the meeting.
4. Professional Development Tour discussion/AO assignments. LCDR Jones stated the chapter has a good way ahead for future events. For professional development tours, the goal is to conduct one per quarter. LCDR Jones requested the group discuss potential professional development tours with their peers and leadership at their respective commands to generate ideas and identify potential AOs. Upcoming tours include the White House as well as DISA and a War College visit. LCDR Jones also stated the chapter should increase the number of Dine to Donate opportunities.
5. Open discussion was held on the benefits of hosting Chapter meetings on or off base. Suggested on base venues included WSS Wardroom, cafeteria, Bldg 14 training rooms and outdoor picnic areas. The benefit of hosting meetings on NSA Mechanicsburg is a reduction in travel time to and from base. CAPT Robert Williams, President, voiced no issues with hosting meetings on base.
6. Closing comments were provided by CAPT Williams. He stated that with the fluidity of day to day scheduling, the organization must remain flexible. CAPT Williams issued a challenge to the group to ensure they are being mentored or in turn, are mentoring a junior Sailor as part of professional development. He also stated there are a lot of roads to success; if you want to be an Admiral you have to start discussing it now with your family. He emphasized the importance of ethical behavior; when in doubt, ask yourself 'What would Grandma do?'. CAPT Williams also suggested the base bowling alley as a possible meeting place to have fun and build camaraderie during meetings.
